## Youth

### ★ Magical Blooming Water Blossoms

## Teen

### ★ Melted Crayon Art

- A dexterous craft that allows for boundless creativity on a budget
  - Materials:
    - · Canvas (can be bought at dollar tree)
    - · Crayons (preferably old crayons)
    - · Glue (preferably hot glue but regular Elmer's glue will do )

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- · Hair dryer
  - · Paint (optional)
  - · Paper (optional)
  - · Tape (optional)
  - Steps:
    - 1. Lay out which color crayons you want to use in a line at the top of your canvas
    - 2. Glue crayons in place and allow 30 minutes-1hr for glue to dry if you use regular glue
    - 3. Take canvas outside and use hairdryer to melt crayons
  - If you want to be creative and challenge yourself, you can arrange the crayons in different patterns such as a heart or star. Or add flare and paint a silhouette just be sure tape over it with either painter's tape or regular tape and paper while melting the crayons to protect it. Remove tape as soon as possible while being careful of the hot wax to avoid burns.
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
